Subject: Amended proposal for a COUNCIL DECISION on the conclusion of the Euro-Mediterranean Aviation Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part, and the Government of the State of Israel, of the other part

– Request by the Council for the consent of the European Parliament

1. The above Agreement is the result of the Commission's mandate granted by the Council on 8 April 2008, to open negotiations with the State of Israel on a comprehensive air transport agreement.
2. On 22 November 2012, the Commission presented to the Council its proposals for Council Decisions on the signature and provisional application of the Agreement and on the conclusion of the Agreement.
3. The Agreement was signed on 10 June 2013. The Decision on the signature and provisional application of the Agreement, together with the text of the Agreement, was published in the *Official Journal of the European Union* on 2 August 2013¹.

4. The ratification process was completed by all Member States on 27 May 2019, except for the Republic of Croatia, but it is intended that the Republic of Croatia will accede to the Agreement in accordance with the procedure provided for in the Act of accession annexed to its Treaty of Accession of 5 December 2011.
5. On 5 November 2019, the Commission submitted an amended proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion of the Agreement, with a view notably to take into account the entry into force of the Treaty of Lisbon and the judgement of the European Court of Justice of 28 April 2015 in the [Case C-28/12](#).
6. The Aviation Working Party discussed the amended proposal and reached agreement on it on 14 November 2019.
7. Following the agreement reached at working party level, the text of the amended Council Decision on the conclusion was revised by the Council's legal-linguistic services.
8. With a view to preparing for the conclusion of the Agreement, COREPER is invited to suggest that the Council, in part "A" of the agenda of a forthcoming meeting, decides to forward the draft decision on conclusion, as contained in J/L document [14207/19](#), as well as the text of the Agreement as contained in J/L document [16828/12](#), to the European Parliament for its consent.
