## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Proposal for a COUNCIL DECISION on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union within the Joint Committee established by the Common Aviation Area Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part - Adoption

- 1. The Commission submitted the above-mentioned proposal for a Council Decision on 25 November 2020.
- 2. The proposal concerns the decision establishing the position to be taken on the Union's behalf in the Joint Committee set up by the Common Aviation Area Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, on the one part, and Georgia, of the other part<sup>1</sup> adopting the Rules of procedure of the Joint Committee.

- 3. The Common Aviation Area Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part, entered into force on 2 August 2020. The Joint Committee established in Article 22 of the Common Aviation Area Agreement is responsible for the administration of the Agreement and ensures its proper implementation.
- 4. The Aviation Working Party examined the draft Council Decision<sup>2</sup> and its annex<sup>3</sup> on 3 December 2020.
- 5. The texts, as agreed upon at the Working Party, have been prepared by the Council's legal-linguistic service<sup>4</sup>.
- 6. Consequently, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to confirm the Working Party's agreement and to suggest to Council to adopt the Council Decision together with its annex as set out in documents 13380/20 and 13385/20 as a "I/A" item at one of its forthcoming sessions.
