Subject:	END OF WRITTEN PROCEDURE Council Implementing Decision granting temporary support under Regulation (EU) 2020/672 to Ireland to mitigate unemployment risks in the emergency following the COVID-19 outbreak - Adoption

Delegations are informed that the written procedure, opened by CM 5003/20 of 2 December 2020, was completed on Friday, 4 December 2020, and that all delegations voted in favour of the adoption of the **Council Implementing Decision granting temporary support under Regulation (EU) 2020/672 to Ireland to mitigate unemployment risks in the emergency following the COVID-19 outbreak**, as set out in document ST 13007/20.

The required qualified majority has been reached. Therefore, the above Council Implementing Decision is adopted.

The statement by Denmark is reproduced in the Annex to this communication and will be included in the summary of acts adopted by the written procedure as a statement to be entered in the Council minutes, in accordance with the third subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure.

"DANISH DECLARATION AT THE TIME OF ADOPTION IN WRITTEN PROCEDURE

Denmark can approve the adoption of the Council Implementing Decision granting temporary support to Ireland under the SURE Regulation, based on the understanding of the Commission's answers to questions raised during the technical discussions, that the implementing act and bilateral loan agreement will comply with the EU's fundamental rights, including non-discrimination, which is a priority for Denmark."
