Subject: Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 6.11.2020 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/1122 as regards the functioning of the Union Registry under Regulation (EU) 2018/841 of the European Parliament and of the Council
- Decision to request an extension of the time-limit

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated regulation¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and in particular Article 15 of Regulation (EU) 2018/841 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2018 on the inclusion of greenhouse gas emissions and removals from land use, land use change and forestry in the 2030 climate and energy framework, and amending Regulation (EU) No 525/2013 and Decision No 529/2013/EU (LULUCF Regulation)².

2. The Commission notified the delegated regulation on 6 November 2020. In accordance with Article 16 of Regulation 2018/841/EU, the Council may object to it up to 7 January 2021.
3. Following a consultation launched by the General Secretariat of the Council, one delegation objected to the delegated regulation and requested an extension of the period for objection. Another delegation also requested an extension.
4. On 7 December 2020, a preliminary exchange of views was held by the members of the Environment Working Party in an informal videoconference. The Presidency concluded that more time was needed to examine the delegated regulation.
5. It is therefore suggested that Coreper recommends that the Council decides to extend the period for raising objections by two months and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
