Appointment of Mr Martins SVIRSKIS, alternate member for Latvia, in place of Ms Linda ROMELE, who has resigned
- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Linda ROMELE, as alternate member of the Management Board of the above Foundation in the trade unions' representatives category (for Latvia).
2. Under Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/127 of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the European Foundation for the improvement of living and working conditions (Eurofound), and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 1365/75, members of the Management Board are appointed by the Council.
