Subject: European Court of Auditors' Special Report No 21/2019: Addressing antimicrobial resistance: progress in the animal sector, but this health threat remains a challenge for the EU
– *Designation of Working Party*

1. On 15 November 2019, the European Court of Auditors published Special Report No 21/2019 entitled "Addressing antimicrobial resistance: progress in the animal sector, but this health threat remains a challenge for the EU"¹.
2. Under the rules laid down in the Council conclusions on improving the examination of special reports drawn up by the Court of Auditors², it is suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee instruct the Working Party on Public Health to examine, with the appropriate involvement of the Working Party of Agriculture Counsellors/Attachés (Agri - Veterinary matters), the report in accordance with those rules.
