Statement by Bulgaria

"While in a spirit of compromise the Republic of Bulgaria can support the 2019 ECOFIN Climate Finance Conclusions, it would like to reiterate its understanding of the new wording used in the first and second paragraphs of the Conclusions, and more specifically the text related to "swift" and "ambitious" progress and implementation of the Paris Agreement and its long-term goals. Bulgaria's understanding is that this text does not provide for and could not be interpreted as an agreement of the Council on potential revision of the 2030 EU Climate goals, nor does it prejudge the decision of the European leaders on the EU's Long Term Climate Goal (by 2050).

Bulgaria reiterates its position, namely:

- The EU binding target, endorsed by the European Council, of at least 40% domestic reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 compared to 1990, as well as the EU goals for energy efficiency and renewable energy until 2030, are the absolute limit for our country and Bulgaria cannot support any further increase of these targets.
- When deciding on the EU long-term goal, it should be taken into account the cost-effectiveness, socio-economic characteristics of the countries, and their potential to sustain and finance the costs associated with the practical implementation of policies that will be incorporated into the future EU strategy, while fully respecting the sovereign right of each Member State to decide on its energy mix.

Bulgaria's understanding is that the Council conclusions should not prevent the financing of natural gas projects, taking into account the significant role of natural gas in the transition to a low carbon economy."

"By its judgement in joined cases C-103/12 and C-165/12 (European Parliament and the Commission v. Council) the Court of Justice clearly confirmed that decisions relating to the conclusion of external fisheries agreements fall fully within the scope of Article 43(2) TFEU (in conjunction with the applicable procedure of Article 218 TFEU, i.e. Article 218(6)(a)(v) for the decisions on the conclusion of the agreements) and rejected the position that such decisions could fall within the scope of Article 43(3) TFEU.
