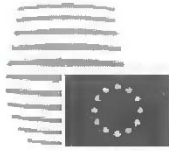


Dear Ms. Tinagli,

Following the informal meetings between the European Parliament and the Council, the compromise texts on the above-mentioned Commission proposals, which form the Capital Markets Recovery Package, were agreed today by the Permanent Representatives' Committee.

I am therefore now in a position to confirm that, should the European Parliament adopt its positions at first reading, in accordance with Article 294 paragraph 3 of the Treaty, in the form set out in the compromise texts contained in the Annex to this letter (subject to revision by the legal linguists of both institutions), the Council would, in accordance with Article 294, paragraph 4 of the Treaty, approve the European Parliament's position and the acts shall be adopted in the working which corresponds to the European Parliament's position.

On behalf of the Council I also wish to thank you for your close cooperation which should enable us to reach agreement on the files from the **Capital Markets Recovery Package** at first reading.
