Subject:	Council approval for the opening of negotiations between the Commission and the Western Balkan partners on a non-binding Joint Declaration on a Western Balkans Agenda on Innovation, Research, Education, Culture, Youth and Sport.
	- Approval of entering into negotiations
	- Decision to use the written procedure

- 1. On 14 December 2020, the Working Party on Research received information from the Commission on the Commission's intention on behalf of the Union to enter into negotiation on a non-binding Joint Declaration on a Western Balkans Agenda on Innovation, Research, Education, Culture, Youth and Sport¹.
- 2. It is expected that the Joint Declaration, and the actions that it will set into motion, underpin the implementation of the Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans². It is envisaged that the Joint Declaration will stress the shared commitment of the Western Balkans and European partners to jointly progress on a European path in the areas of Innovation, Research, Education, Culture, Youth and Sport.

 - to confirm its approval for the Commission to enter into negotiation on behalf of the
 Union on a non-binding Joint Declaration on a Western Balkans Agenda on Innovation,
 Research, Education, Culture, Youth and Sport, and
 - to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's
 Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/1659, that the Council uses
 the written procedure for the approval to enter into negotiations.
