Subject:	Council approval for the opening of negotiations between the Commission and the participants of the Arctic Science Ministerial on a Joint Statement on collaborative science efforts in the Arctic.
	- Approval of entering into negotiations
	- Decision to use the written procedure

- On 14 December 2020, the <u>Working Party on Research</u> received information from the <u>Commission</u> on its intention to enter into negotiations on a non-binding Joint Statement on collaborative science efforts in the Arctic¹.
- 2. It is expected that the Joint Statement will stress concern over warming in the Arctic region and its regional and planetary impacts. The Joint Statement is expected to present joint policy commitments under four priority themes:
 - Observe Observing networks; Data sharing –towards implementation;
 - Understand Enhance understanding and prediction capability on Arctic environmental and social systems and its global impact;

- Respond Sustainable development; Evaluation of vulnerability and resilience; Application of knowledge;
- Strengthen Capacity building; Education; Networking; Resilience prepare the next generation.
- 3. It is understood that the <u>Commission</u> will revert to the <u>Council</u> at the end of the negotiations to seek approval by the Council for signing up to that non-binding Joint Statement.
- 4. In view of the above, the <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is invited:
 - to confirm its approval for the Commission to enter into negotiations on a Joint
 Statement on collaborative science efforts in the Arctic, and
 - to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/1659, that the <u>Council</u> uses the written procedure for the approval to enter into negotiations.
