TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS N° DEC 28/2020

INTRODUCTION

The so-called "End-of-year Transfer" is intended to ensure that, insofar as possible, the outstanding invoices related to funds in shared management can be honoured, by making full use of available payment appropriations.

The rules governing this transfer are set out in Article 31(2) of the Regulation (EU, EURATOM) No 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the European Union.

The "End of Year Transfer" for the 2020 exercise relates to payment appropriations amounting to **EUR 95,3 million** in total, which takes into account the actual implementation of expenditure in mid-December 2020.

1. Reinforcements

The transfer proposes to reinforce the payment appropriations of **3 budget lines** under following headings/programmes:

Heading 1b - Economic, social & territorial cohesion

+ EUR 48,3 million

- to the European Social Fund (EUR 24,1 million), and
- to the European Regional Development Fund (EUR 24,1 million);
- Heading 2 Sustainable growth natural resources

- + EUR 47,0 million
- to the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development.

These reinforcements will allow outstanding claims to be covered, and reimburse Member States for payments already undertaken in shared management.

2. Reductions

Justifications

Increased 04 02 60

European Social Fund -- Less developed regions -- Investment for growth and jobs goal

In 2020, many Member States opted for increased 100% co-financing in accordance with the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative Plus (CRII+). This resulted in increased payment needs, higher than initially foreseen. Therefore, based on the current state of implementation, submission of payment claims and Member states forecasts, the reinforcement by EUR 24,1 million in payment appropriations is needed to reimburse applications submitted by national authorities.

Decreased 04 02 63 02

European Social Fund -- Operational technical assistance managed by the Commission at the request of a Member State

Following the revision of the forecast for payments, an amount of EUR 0,2 million will not be used before the end of the vear and can therefore be made available.

Decreased 04 03 02 03

Microfinance and Social Entrepreneurship -- Increasing access to, and the availability of, financing for legal and physical persons, especially those furthest from the labour market, and social enterprises

The available assigned revenues exceed the estimates made at the time of drafting budget 2020. Besides, the European Investment Fund (EIF) communicated in November that they will be able to absorb only a small tranche of the initially estimated needs. Therefore, the needs in payment appropriations for 2020 are lower than initially estimated, and an amount of EUR 8,3 million can be made available.

Decreased 04 03 15

European Labour Authority (ELA)

The Covid-19 crisis has slowed down significantly the recruitment of staff and has delayed the move to Bratislava and the signature of the related contracts. Therefore, an amount of EUR 3 million in payment appropriations can be made available. The remaining availabilities (up to EUR 9 million) will be transferred to the Employment and Social Innovation programme and prerogatives budget lines.

Decreased 05 02 10 02

Promotion measures -- Direct payments by the Union

Due to delays caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the pre-financing payments for some grant agreements signed in 2020 cannot be made this year. For the same reason, a number of procurement contracts were subject to suspensions and terminations. The total impact, reinforced by the restrictions of the second Covid-19 wave, turned out to be more significant than estimated in the context of the global transfer exercise in August 2020. Therefore, an amount of EUR 9.6 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Increased 05 04 60 01

Promoting sustainable rural development, a more territorially and environmentally balanced, climate-friendly and innovative Union agricultural sector

For the 2014-2020 rural development programmes financed by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD), Member State's declarations of expenditure for the third quarter of 2020 allow for the execution of additional payment appropriations for an amount of EUR 47 million.

Decreased 05 05 03 02

Support for economic, social and territorial development and related progressive alignment with the Union acquis

The negative impact of Covid-19 has resulted in, inter alia, slower progress of projects because of movement restrictions of workers, economic pressure on recipients and movement restrictions of national payment agencies' staff preventing the on-the-spot controls foreseen in approval procedures. This has led to less payment to projects than expected and a corresponding reduction of the expected declarations of expenditure by candidate countries, which resulted in a reduced need of payment appropriations. Therefore, an amount of EUR 4.2 million can be made available.

Decreased 05 08 03

Restructuring of systems for agricultural surveys

Two payments were initially planned in 2020 for the integrated Modelling Platform for Agro-economic Commodity and Policy Analysis (iMAP). Taking into account the eventually agreed payments, an amount of EUR 14 000 in payment appropriations can be made available.

Decreased 05 08 77 16

Preparatory action -- Smart rural areas in the 21st century

The contract related to this preparatory action indicates that the payments will be made in four instalments. According to the payment schedule, only one payment of EUR 0,7 million is scheduled for this year. Therefore, an amount of EUR 3 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- Developing a farmers-- toolbox for integrated pest management practices from across the Union

An open call for tenders is under preparation for this pilot project. Since the corresponding individual commitment will only be made in 2021, no payments will take place this year and all payment appropriations on this budget line amounting to EUR 0,8 million can be made available.

Pilot project -- Establishing an operational programme: structuring the agri-food sectors to safeguard the handing-on of family farms and the sustainability of local agriculture

The open call for tenders related to this pilot project was launched in July 2020. According to the payment schedule foreseen in the contract awarded, no payments are scheduled for 2020. Therefore, all payment appropriations available on this budget line amounting to EUR 0,5 million can be made available.

Pilot project -- Media councils in the digital era

Following an extension of the duration of this pilot project, the final payment has been postponed to the first Quarter of 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0.1 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Most of the workshops for this pilot project have been postponed to 2021. Therefore, only one interim payment was made in 2020 and an amount of EUR 0.2 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

For this preparatory action, two of the three interim payments forecasted in 2020 have been postponed to the first quarter of 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,3 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- A European public sphere: a new online media offer for young Europeans

For this pilot project, the pre-financing forecasted in 2020 has been postponed to the first Quarter of 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,1 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- Developing a strategic research, innovation and implementation agenda and a roadmap for achieving full digital language equality in Europe by 2030

Horizon 2020 -- Customer-driven scientific and technical support to Union policies

Due to the sanitary crisis, the execution of contracts has slowed down. As the appropriations on this budget line are implemented mainly through procurement and payments on deliverables, it is not expected that the delays can be recovered by year-end. Therefore, an amount of EUR 7,3 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- Organisation of large-scale events -- `Science meets Parliaments and Regions`

This Pilot Project is finalised. As the output required from the contractor was only partially delivered, the final payment was reduced and the amount of EUR 6 185 can be made available.

European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) -- More developed regions -- Investment for growth and jobs goal

In 2020, many Member States opted for increased 100% co-financing in accordance with the Coronavirus Response Investment Initiative Plus (CRII+). This resulted in increased payment needs, higher than initially foreseen. Therefore, based on the current state of implementation, submission of payment claims and Member states forecasts, the reinforcement by EUR 24,1 million in payment appropriations is needed to reimburse applications submitted by national authorities.

European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) -- Operational technical assistance managed by the Commission at the request of a Member State

Due to delays in the signature of some agreements, the forecast for payments has been revised and an amount of EUR 0.6 million can be made available.

Cohesion Fund -- Operational technical assistance managed by the Commission at the request of a Member State

A small leftover of EUR 4 612 will not be used before the end of 2020 and can be made available.

Strengthening the financial capacity of SMEs and small and very small organisations in the European cultural and creative sectors, and fostering policy development and new business models

Disbursements to the European Investment Fund (EIF) will be significantly lower than estimated. This surplus is further increased by the extreme constraints on events due to the Covid-19. In addition some payments related to the "Module for master degrees in art and science" projects as well as the Lux Prize will be shifted to 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 10,2 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

European Solidarity Corps

Taking into account the particular circumstances caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, some activities were impacted and/or postponed, particularly those managed by National Agencies. This concerns the traineeships and jobs, the training for participants, the insurance and other complementary activities. The payments initially foreseen on this budget line are therefore postponed to 2021, and an amount of EUR 15 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

The single payment on this budget line was made. Due to the exchange rate differences an amount of EUR 63 300 in payment appropriations remains on the line and can be made available.

The payment foreseen for this preparatory action is postponed to 2021, pending clarification on the final amount to be paid. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,6 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

The payment foreseen for this pilot project is postponed to 2021, pending clarification on the final amount to be paid. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,2 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- Integrate: development of integrated strategies to monitor and treat chronic and rheumatic diseases: the role of quality indicators and patient-reported outcomes in addition to physician evaluation of disease activity and damage

The final request for payment for this pilot project was not received. Therefore, the payment is postponed to 2021 and an amount of EUR 0,2 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Completion of former actions (prior to 2014)

A majority of activities related to the Instrument for Nuclear Safety Cooperation are affected by the Covid-19 pandemic, resulting in delays in contracting, implementation and payments. All the corresponding contracts are affected to a different extent. Therefore, an amount of EUR 3,5 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Evaluation of the results of Union aid and follow-up and audit measures

The surplus of EUR 1,3 million on this budget line is mainly due to:

- delays in the implementation of ongoing contracts for Results Oriented Monitoring and evaluations due to the Covid-19 crisis limiting the possibilities to evaluate the projects on the ground;
- the postponement to 2021 of the contracting related to the 2020 financial decision, adopted in October 2020. As a result, the pre-financing payments initially expected in 2020 will only be made in 2021.

Coordination and promotion of awareness on development issues and on the enlargement and neighbourhood policies

Due to the Covid-19 crisis, the execution of many contracts, especially those related to the organisation of events (in particular European Development Days 2020) have been delayed or cancelled. This has severely affected the level of consumption of payment appropriations. Consequently, an amount of EUR 2 million can be made available.

EU Aid Volunteers initiative -- Strengthening the Union's capacity to respond to humanitarian crises

Due to the measures implemented to limit the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic, such as travel restrictions, and the uncertainty regarding the duration of such measures, the implementation of the annual programme was considerably impacted. The deployment call has been cancelled and the training of the volunteers selected under the 2019 deployment call will only be partially contracted. Consequently, an amount of EUR 9,6 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Procedures for awarding and advertising public supply, works and service contracts

Following the postponement of the eNotices2 project initially planned in 2019 and launched in May 2020, some payments will be postponed to 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,3 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Interoperability solutions and common frameworks for European public administrations, businesses and citizens (ISA²)

Contracts were signed in the middle of the Covid-19 outbreak that affected the related activities, for example restrictions on accessing customer's premises in several sites in Europe. Therefore, some payments are postponed to 2021 and an amount of UER 0,2 million can be made available.

Providing quality statistical information, implementing new methods of production of European statistics and strengthening the partnership within the European Statistical System

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the National Statistical Institutes encountered difficulties in the implementation of grants. As a result of delays in the publications and signature of the grant agreements, some pre-financing payments will be postponed to 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 3,5 million can be made available.

Completion of financial support for projects of common interest in the trans-European energy network

No further invoices will be received until the end of the year. Therefore, the remaining amount of EUR 0,5 million can be made available.

Preparatory action -- Strengthening cooperation on climate action among islands within and beyond the Union through the creation of an island identity within the Global Covenant of Mayors

No further invoices will be received until the end of the year. Therefore, the remaining amount of EUR 0,4 million can be made available.

Pilot project -- Feasibility study for distributed ledger technology applied to the European energy market

The latest payment forecast shows that EUR 0,1 million will still be available at the end of the year and are therefore made available.

Preparatory action -- Establishing comprehensive support for coal and carbon-intensive regions in transition

The signature of a contribution agreement with the European Investment Bank Jasper Fund is delayed. In addition, the signature of the contribution agreement with the World Bank will be signed in December 2020. Subsequently, the related payments will be postponed to 2021 and an amount of EUR 5,3 million can be made available.

Pilot project -- Advancing industrial decarbonisation by assessing the use of renewable energies in industrial processes

No further invoices will be received until the end of the year. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,3 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Pilot project -- Covenant of Mayors as an instrument to tackle energy poverty

Following delays in the signature of the contract for this pilot project, the related payments will be postponed to 2021 and an amount of EUR 1,5 million can be made available.

Preparatory action -- Strengthening cooperation on climate action among villages in the EU and beyond through the creation of a rural identity within the Covenant of Mayors

Following delays in the signature of the contract for this preparatory action, the related payments will be postponed to 2021 and an amount of EUR 0,5 million can be made available.

Nuclear safeguards

Due to the second wave of the Covid-19 crisis, the number of missions of nuclear inspectors was reduced again (in particular due to travel restrictions imposed by the medical service on nuclear inspectors older than 60). In addition, there will be a decrease in the payments to the IT consortiums as the number of working days that will be invoiced is also impacted by this situation. Therefore, an amount of EUR 1 million can be made available.

Differentiated appropriations

The remaining payment appropriations of EUR 0,4 million on this reserve line are not needed in 2020 and can be made available for redeployment.
