	 Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

- On 27 September 2017 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Article 91(1) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 18 January 2018².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted and decided not to issue an opinion.
- 4. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 15 November 2018³.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed the provisional agreement reached in trilogues on 21 October 2020.
- 6. Subsequently, on 29 October 2020 the <u>European Parliament Committee on Transport and Tourism (TRAN)</u> confirmed the provisional agreement and its chair sent a letter on 30 October 2020 to the chair of Coreper declaring that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic review) without amendments.
- 7. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is asked to suggest that the Council:
 - adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 12262/20 and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 12262/20 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
