Subject: COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 27.1.2021 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/884 derogating in respect of the year 2020 from Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/891 as regards the fruit and vegetables sector and from Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/1149 as regards the wine sector in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic, and amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/1149
- Intention not to raise objection to a delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Articles 62(1), 64(6) and 115(4) of Regulation (EU) No 1306/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013, and with Articles 53(b) and (h), and 227(4) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 17 December 2013. The Commission having notified the delegated act on 27 January 2021, the Council may object to it until 28 March 2021.
2. On 8 February 2021, the Special Committee on Agriculture (SCA) confirmed the outcome of the silence consultation launched on 28 January 2021 by which delegations considered there were no grounds for the Council to object to the delegated act. The SCA also agreed to inform the Parliament and the Commission, prior to the expiry of the period for objecting.

3. Therefore the SCA suggests that the Council, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, confirm that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament be informed thereof. This implies that, unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force in accordance with Article 115(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1306/2013 and Article 227(5) of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013.
