On behalf of the Irish Government, I hereby submit notification of the national measures taken in accordance with Article 27(2) of Framework Decision 2009/829/JHA of 23 October 2009.

Ireland has notified the Commission of the transposition of this Framework Decision by the enactment and commencement of the Criminal Justice (Mutual Recognition of Decisions on Supervision Measures) Act 2020. This Act was commenced in full on 5 February 2021. The text of this Act is attached at Annex 1.

**Notification pursuant to Article 6(1):**

Pursuant to Article 6(1) of the Framework Decision, the General Secretariat of the Council is hereby notified of the following competent authorities:

Where Ireland is the issuing State, a court competent to impose supervision measures on the person concerned.

Where Ireland is the executing State, the District Court, or, in the case of certain offences, the High Court.

**Notification pursuant to Article 7(3)**

Pursuant to Article 7(3), the Minister for Justice will be the Central Authority in accordance with the Framework Decision.

Pursuant to Article 9(4), Ireland will not consent to the forwarding of a decision on supervision measures in cases pursuant to Article 9(2).


**Declaration pursuant to Article 14(4)**
