The Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and has the honour to refer to the Council's notification of 21 May 2019 and its own notification of 1 July 2021, the latter informing the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union of the acceptance of the below mentioned legal acts, subject to the fulfilment of constitutional requirements in Liechtenstein in accordance with the second and third sentence of Article 5(2)(a) in combination with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol.

In accordance with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol, the Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union has the honour to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union that the constitutional requirements regarding the following acts have been fulfilled, thereby making the acts binding on Liechtenstein:
