- The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Mr Jens TROLDBORG as alternate member of the above Committee in the employers' representatives category (for Denmark).
- Under Article 75 of Regulation (EC) 883/2004 of 29 April 2004<sup>1</sup> which sets up the Advisory Committee for the Coordination of Social Security Systems, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council, whereas by the Council Decision of 21 September 2020<sup>2</sup>, the appointments are valid for a period of five years.
