Subject: Draft DECISION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Council Decisions 2003/17/EC and 2005/834/EC as regards the equivalence of field inspections and the equivalence of checks on practices for the maintenance of varieties of agricultural plant species carried out in the United Kingdom **(first reading)**  
- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the legislative act

---

1. On 23 December 2020, the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 43(2)TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 27 January 2021<sup>2</sup>.
3. The European Parliament will adopt its position at first reading on the Commission proposal at its plenary on 8-11 March 2021.
