TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS N° DEC 01/2021

INTRODUCTION

The present transfer proposal concerns those pilot projects and preparatory actions (PP/PAs) adopted under the 2021 budget that were assessed by the Commission as category C (fully covered by a legal base or the ideas are otherwise being addressed) in its 'executability letter' of 17 November 2020¹.

As indicated in the 'executability letter', it is proposed to transfer the commitment and payment appropriations related to these PP/PAs to the appropriate budget line of the existing programmes covering the proposed activities.

This 2021 exercise relates to 3 preparatory actions and 9 pilot projects for a total value of EUR 6,7 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 2,6 million in payment appropriations. Appropriations of one C rated project will be transferred to a programme in Heading 6 in an upcoming Draft Amending budget, as they impact the amount of Flexibility instrument mobilised under Heading 2b.

All proposed transfers are detailed by budget line in the following tables in budget nomenclature order, indicating:

- the initial budget appropriations, including amending budgets as of 23 February 2021;
- transfers as of 23 February 2021;
- the implementation as of 23 February 2021;
- the total remaining available appropriations;
- proposed transfer (increase or reduction);
- percentage change, compared to the initial budget (including any amending budgets);
- the balance on the line after the proposed transfer.

For reductions and related reinforcements of the authorised appropriations on the budget line, detailed justifications are provided in the enclosure.

Justifications

Decreased PA 03 20 05

Preparatory action -- Assessing alleged differences in the quality of products sold on the internal market

This 2021 preparatory action cannot be implemented since the implementation of the 2020 preparatory action for the same subject is ongoing and the initially allocated budget is sufficient to cover the objectives. Any further allocation would create a significant risk of under execution. Therefore, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this preparatory action (EUR 0,9 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 0,5 million in payment appropriations) to the operational budget line 03 02 04 01.

Increased 03 02 04 01

Ensuring high level of consumer protection and product safety

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the preparatory action — Assessing alleged differences in the quality of products sold on the internal market.

Decreased PA 03 21 01

Preparatory action -- The European Crisis-management mechanism for the Tourism sector

This preparatory action cannot be implemented because it is already covered by existing EU level crisis management structures and processes, such as the Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC) and the Integrated Political Crisis Response (IPCR). Furthermore, structures for EU level cooperation on tourism already exist, in particular the Tourism Advisory Committee and the regular tourism ministers' meetings to coordinate and complement actions taken by individual Member States, in line with the competences under Article 195 of the Treaty. The EU financial support for the tourism ecosystem is possible by various EU financing programmes managed by the Commission. Therefore, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this preparatory action (EUR 2,5 million in commitment appropriations) to budget line 03 02 02.

Increased 03 02 02

Improving the competitiveness of enterprises, particularly SMEs, and supporting their access to markets

The Commission had indicated in the executability letter of 17/11/2020 that the appropriations would be proposed to be transferred to budget line 03 02 01 01 (Operation and development of the internal market of goods and services). However, after further careful consideration of the work programmes we will propose to the budgetary authority to transfer the appropriations to budget line 03 02 02 (Improving the competitiveness of enterprises, particularly SMEs, and supporting their access to markets), where efficient synergies on Tourism actions can easily be attained.

This will allow the financing of actions to support tourism SMEs in the recovery from the Covid-19 crisis and in particular for preparing them for the green and digital transformation, boosting their resilience and ability to innovate. In addition, the appropriations would also be used to map the governance structures and processes that managed tourism during the pandemic and to identify the data and data sources, which are essential for the tourism industry and administrations to navigate through a crisis and to inform corrective actions and remedy measures. Moreover, the funds may also be used to provide expert support to national and regional administrations to help them improve tourism governance, resilience and crisis preparedness.

Decreased PA 07 20 06

Preparatory action -- Roma Civil Monitor -- Strengthening capacity and involvement of Roma and pro-Roma civil society in policy monitoring and review

This preparatory action cannot be implemented since the implementation of the 2020 preparatory action for the same subject is ongoing and the initially allocated budget is sufficient to cover the objectives. Any further allocation would create a significant risk of under execution. Therefore, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this preparatory action (EUR 1 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 0,9 million in payment appropriations) to the operational budget line 07 06 01.

Increased 07 06 01

Promote equality and rights

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the preparatory action - Roma Civil Monitor -- Strengthening capacity and involvement of Roma and pro-Roma civil society in policy monitoring and review.

Decreased PP 04 21 01

Pilot project -- Pandemic EU-wide management

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, the objective of the pilot project was to build a standardised solution for the Covid-19 monitoring in the EU. But given the urgency to monitor the health crisis on the EU level, the purpose of this pilot project was already implemented through an interoperability gateway service for national contact tracing and warning applications developed by the European Commission in close cooperation with the Member States. With regard to the technical specifications, the pilot project proposed to use anonymised positioning, navigation and timing services provided by European global satellite system Galileo. While recognising the added value of Galileo, in particular its accuracy and the use of dual-frequency, the EU toolbox includes mobile applications for contact tracing that are based on proximity data and are thus more compatible with privacy and data protection aspects.

Therefore, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 1 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 0,3 million in payment appropriations) to budget line 02 04 03.

Increased 02 04 03

Artificial Intelligence

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Pandemic EU-wide management.

Decreased PP 07 21 06

Pilot project -- Enabling greater gender budget responsiveness of the next MFF through an gender impact assessment

The 2021-2027 MFF ensure the integration of gender equality considerations throughout the Framework generally, and more specifically in various EU funding programmes. The proposals for the new spending programmes were based on impact assessments carried out in line with standard requirements and practice of the Better Regulation agenda. All MFF proposals were screened for numerous impact categories, including gender impacts. The depth of analysis was always proportionate to the significance of the expected impacts. Therefore, the proposed pilot project would duplicate the completed tasks as well as the ongoing work, and thus would not provide added value. Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 60 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 15 000 in payment appropriations) to the operational budget line 07 06 01 under the Programme "Citizenship, Equality Rights and Values".

Increased 07 06 01

Promote equality and rights

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Enabling greater gender budget responsiveness of the next MFF through an gender impact assessment.

Decreased PP 07 21 10

Pilot project -- Education Platform on Rule of Law

The scope of this Pilot Project was to develop an educational package with interactive modules on the Rule of Law for teachers and pupils in secondary education across the EU. However, support to the development of content and educational packages is already offered under the Erasmus+ programme, notably in Key Action 2: strategic partnerships projects, which aim to support exchanges of best practices and encourage innovative pedagogical approaches for improving teaching and learning. Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 0,4 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 0,1 million in payment appropriations) to the operational budget line 07 03 01 01.

Increased 07 03 01 01

Promoting learning mobility of individuals, as well as cooperation, inclusion, excellence, creativity and innovation at the level of organisations and policies in the field of education and training -- Indirect management

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Education Platform on Rule of Law.

Decreased PP 07 21 12

Pilot project -- Improving the employment for persons with disabilities through the inclusive enterprise model

This Pilot Project cannot be implemented because it is already covered by the following existing and forthcoming legislation/activities such as initiatives from the Employment and Social Innovation (EaSI) programme, the European Social Fund and Erasmus. The inclusive enterprises already exist, and social enterprises were already financed by the EaSI programme as well as under European Structural and Investment Funds 2014-2020. The Commission will present actions to increase employment of people with disabilities in the new European Disability Strategy in 2021, following the ongoing preparatory work and exchanges with stakeholders. Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 150 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 37 500 in payment appropriations) to the operational budget line 07 02 04.

Increased 07 02 04

ESF+ -- Employment and Social Innovation strand

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Improving the employment for persons with disabilities through the inclusive enterprise model.

Decreased PP 07 21 13

Pilot project -- Domestic Violence - Assessment of the impact of programs targeting aggressors as an instrument to prevent their recurrence in different European countries

This pilot project is fully covered by the Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values programme (CERV). More specifically, the proposed topic can be covered under the Daphne strand of the programme to prevent and combat all forms of violence against children, young people and women, as well as violence against other groups at risk, in particular groups at risk of violence in close relationships, and to protect victims of such violence.

Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 150 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 37 500 in payment appropriations) to budget line 07 06 03.

Increased 07 06 03

Daphne

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project - Domestic Violence - Assessment of the impact of programs targeting aggressors as an instrument to prevent their recurrence in different European countries.

Decreased PP 07 21 15

Pilot project -- Establishing an EU app for domestic violence victims

This pilot project is fully covered by the Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values programme (CERV). More specifically, the proposed topic can be covered under the Daphne strand of the programme to prevent and combat all forms of violence against children, young people and women, as well as violence against other groups at risk, in particular groups at risk of violence in close relationships, and to protect victims of such violence. Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 150 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 37 500 in payment appropriations) to budget line 07 06 03.

Increased 07 06 03

Daphne

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Establishing an EU app for domestic violence victims.

Pilot project -- Integrating Al into the circular economy

This pilot project proposal cannot be implemented because it is already covered by the Circular Economy Action Plan (CEAP) adopted by the Commission in 2020 (COM(2020)98), that specifies further actions, legislative proposals, policies, strategies and instruments to be developed through and in the follow up to the CEAP.

Additional programmes, such as Horizon 2020, Cohesion and LIFE have dedicated significant funds for circular economy projects. Horizon 2020 in particular had targeted initiatives on information and communication technologies, including artificial intelligence (AI) and supported the objectives of the circular economy such as resource and energy efficiency.

Further investments are also planned in the upcoming Digital Europe Programme (DEP), which foresees a reinforced role of circular economy requirements, especially in the key technological areas including AI. The White Paper on Artificial Intelligence - issued by the Commission in February 2020, outlines further actions promoting the uptake of AI and development of AI ecosystem integrated with the circular economy.

Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 60 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 15 000 in payment appropriations) to budget line 02 04 03 (Digital Europe Programme, budget line dealing with the Interoperability gateway service).

Artificial Intelligence

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Integrating AI into the circular economy.

Decreased PP 09 21 03

Pilot project -- Assessing Options for use of hydrogen in shipping

This pilot project cannot be implemented as it is already covered by the existing and forthcoming legislation/activities financed under Horizon 2020 programme, specifically by the Fuel Cells and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking. In addition, the FuelEU Maritime initiative focusses on the uptake of alternative marine fuels. Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 180 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 45 000 in payment appropriations) to budget line 02 03 01.

Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) -- Transport

As mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to reinforce the present budget line by the 2021 appropriations allocated to the pilot project – Assessing Options for use of hydrogen in shipping.

Pilot project -- European Observatory on the fight against Impunity

This pilot project cannot be implemented because it is already covered by the future legal base of Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI). The topic is highly relevant and in line with the EU's commitments under the EU Global Strategy, the EU Integrated Approach to Conflict and Crises and the new EU Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy 2020-2024. Upholding human rights, justice and accountability are among the thematic priorities proposed for the future Human Rights and Democracy thematic programme of the NDICI. The Commission would consider activities related to strengthening partnerships and capacity of key stakeholders to perform advocacy, monitoring and support to relevant bodies, including parliaments, as part of its future actions within the thematic programme Human Rights and Democracy of the NDICI aimed at fighting impunity and ensuring accountability for most serious crimes.

Therefore, as mentioned in the Commission executability letter of 17/11/2020, it is proposed to transfer the appropriations allocated to this pilot project (EUR 175 000 in commitment appropriations and EUR 43 750 in payment appropriations) to budget line 14 02 02 11.
