State of play on the Horizontal and CMO Regulations

Exchange of views on the new delivery model

The SCA took note of the Presidency texts for the proposed Horizontal and CMO Regulations and of the state of play of the examination in the Working Parties, as set out in documents 14465/19 and 14535/19, and of the comments expressed by delegations and the Commission.

The Presidency texts of the Horizontal and CMO Regulations would not formally be presented to Ministers at the "Agriculture and Fisheries Council" on 16-17 December but they would provide background to the progress report covering all three CAP post-2020 legislative proposals. This progress report would be presented to the SCA on 9 December.

The SCA exchanged views on the new delivery model on the basis of the Presidency paper set out in document 14550/19. The SCA also took note of delegations' and the Commission's comments on it.

The Presidency noted that there is substantial support for a number of principles suggested in the Presidency paper for the way forward, particularly on the fact that the content of the CAP Strategic Plans should be strategic in nature and limited to the elements that are needed for the plan's approval. At the same time, the Presidency noted delegations' diverging views on a number of other points, particularly on the frequency of milestones and performance review as well as on the reporting of non-area-/animal-based interventions.
