Appointment of Mr Romolo De CAMILLIS, member for Italy, in place of Ms Aviana Maria Teresa BULGARELLI, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Aviana Maria Teresa BULGARELLI, as member of the Management Board of the above Foundation in the government representatives category (for Italy).
2. Under Article 4 of Regulation (EU) 2019/127 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 January 2019 establishing the European Foundation for the improvement of living and working conditions (Eurofound), and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 1365/75, members of the Management Board are appointed by the Council.
