Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council
establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and
Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination
Centres **(first reading)**
- Decision to use the written procedure for the adoption of the Council's
position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

1. On 12 September 2018 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 173(3) and the first paragraph of Article 188 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 23 January 2019².
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on 17 April 2019³.

4. On 18 December 2020, the Permanent Representatives Committee confirmed the final compromise text reached in trilogues on the above draft Regulation.
5. On 14 January 2021, the European Parliament's Committee on Industry, Research and Energy endorsed the final compromise text and by the means of a letter of the same date, the Chair of the European Parliament's Committee on Industry, Research and Energy informed the Chair of the Permanent Representatives Committee that the European Parliament should, at second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading without amendments.
6. Due to the special circumstances, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision (EU) 2021/454⁴, that the Council uses the written procedure for the adoption of its position at first reading on the draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing the European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and the Network of National Coordination Centres as set out in document 5628/21, and the statement of reasons as set out in document 5628/21 ADD 1.
