<u>The SCA</u> took note of the scrutiny reservation entered by FR and agreed to invite the Council to adopt the Decision, as an "A" item, at a forthcoming meeting.¹

a) Regulation on CAP Strategic Plans

<u>The SCA</u> exchanged views on the provisional agreements reached at the "super-trilogue" on 26 March 2021 on the new delivery model and targeting of support. <u>The Presidency</u> will take the views expressed into consideration with a view to the continuation of inter-institutional negotiations on these subjects.



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¹ LU, supported by other delegations, enquired about the Commission report on the ongoing negotiations on mutual recognition of rules in the organic sector announced during the SCA meeting of 7 September 2020. The Commission representative undertook to investigate and report back.

In addition, <u>the SCA</u> exchanged views on the Presidency suggestions on how to address the issues of capping, degressivity and redistribution, as well as on the ring-fencing for eco-schemes. <u>The Presidency</u> will take into account the outcome of the meeting when continuing the negotiations with the European Parliament on the Regulation on CAP Strategic Plans.

b) Regulation on the financing, management and monitoring of the CAP

<u>The SCA</u> took note of the information from the Presidency on the state of play of the negotiations on the Horizontal Regulation. It also took note of the comments from delegations and the Commission, including on the issues of funds resulting from reductions in payments (Art. 39a) and of the reintroduction of the so-called 50/50 rule (Art. 53a).

c) Regulation on common market organisation (CMO) of agricultural products

<u>The SCA</u> took note of the information from the Presidency on the state of play of the negotiations on the CMO Regulation and endorsed the provisional agreements reached at the super-trilogue on 26 March, the technical meetings and the CMO trilogue on 24 March. <u>The Presidency</u> took note of the observations and comments made by the Commission and by delegations.

5. Organisation of future work

<u>The Presidency</u> informed the SCA about the forthcoming CAP reform trilogues, the SCA meeting on 19 April and the informal videoconference of the Ministers of Agriculture on 26 April 2021.

<u>The German delegation</u> informed the SCA that they will ask, at the next COREPER meeting, for an AOB item to be tabled at that videoconference, on the labelling of foodstuffs containing eggs regarding the farming method of laying hens.
