Subject:	Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) .../... of 30.10.2019 amending Directive 2014/23/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council in respect of the threshold for concessions - Intention not to raise objections to a Delegated Act

1. On 30 October 2019, the Commission submitted the above delegated act to the Council in accordance with the procedure in Article 290 TFEU and the mechanism of calculation in Articles 9(1), 9(3), Article 48 of the latest consolidated version, and Article 49 for the use of urgency procedure, set out in Directive 2014/23/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council in respect of the threshold for concessions¹.
2. The delegated act is based on Articles 9(1)(3)(4) of Directive 2014/23/EU. The Council has until 30 December 2019 to object to it.

3. The Working Party on Public Procurement examined the delegated act by silent procedure, and by 2 December 2019 concluded that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

 4. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee could invite the Council to confirm that the Council has no intention to object to the delegated act, and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that unless the European Parliament objects to it, the delegated act as set out in document ST 13696/19 shall be published and enter into force on 1 January 2020 in accordance with Article 54 of Directive 2014/23/EU.
