Delegations are informed that the third session of the 7<sup>th</sup> round of the negotiation for the renewal of the agreement and protocol under the EU-Mauritania Fisheries Partnership Agreement will be held in Las Palmas de Gran Canaria (Spain), on 20, 21 and 22 May 2021 (doc. WK 6211/21 + ADD 1).

The starting times shown above are in local time and are indicative.

**A first EU coordination meeting will be held on Thursday 20 May at 9:00 local time (10:00 Brussels time).** Further coordination meetings will be organised as necessary. Coordination meetings will be chaired by the Portuguese Presidency.

Due to the Covid-19 situation, the negotiation will be held in a hybrid format. EU coordination meetings will be held via WebEx, even for those physically on the spot, to allow those who cannot travel to participate.

For delegations travelling to Las Palmas, EU coordination meetings will be held at the Hôtel Cristina by Tigotan (Calle Gomera 6, Playa Las Canteras, Las Palmas).
