Subject: Transfer of appropriations No DEC 07/2021 within Section III - Commission
- of the general budget for 2021

1. On 27 April 2021, the Commission submitted to the Council proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 07/2021 related to the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF/2020/003 DE/GMH Guss)¹.
2. The purpose of this transfer is to move an amount of EUR 1 081 706 in commitment appropriations from Article 30 04 02 (*Reserve for the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund*) to Item 16 02 99 01 (*Completion of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (prior to 2021)*), as recorded in document 8247/21.

3. The Budget Committee examined this proposal for a transfer at its meeting on 19 May 2021.
 4. Following that examination, the Budget Committee agreed, by a qualified majority, to suggest that the Permanent Representatives Committee:
 - advise the Council to approve the proposed transfer of appropriations, as set out in document 8247/21, and
