Subject:	Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund following an application from Germany (EGF/2020/003 DE/GMH Guss)

1. On 27 April 2021, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the mobilisation of the European Globalisation Adjustment Fund (EGF), accompanied by the corresponding proposal for transfer of appropriations No DEC 07/2021<sup>1</sup>.
2. The proposal aims at mobilising an amount of EUR 1 081 706 under the EGF to meet an application from Germany to deploy the Fund following redundancies in four subsidiaries of company GMH Guss GmbH in order to provide assistance for re-integrating the 476 targeted beneficiaries into the labour market, in line with Regulation (EC) No 1309/2013<sup>2</sup>. The redundancies were caused by the major structural changes in world trade patterns due to globalisation.

3. The Budget Committee examined the proposal at its meeting on 19 May 2021 and was able to approve it.
