Subject:	COUNCIL DECISION appointing one member of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for Portugal

- The Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers, by its Decision of 21 September 2020¹ However, it remained to appoint certain members and alternate members at a later stage.
- Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union², and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council for a period of two years.
- A nomination of one member for Portugal, of the renewed Advisory Committee, has been received by the Council Secretariat, as set out in the draft Council Decision in doc. 8980/21³.
