On 22 April 2021, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 8275/21 + ADD 1) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC<sup>1</sup>, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC<sup>2</sup>, laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Working Party on Foodstuffs (Attachés) considered, through an informal written consultation<sup>3</sup>, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
