Delegations will find attached a table with information about the state of play concerning the implementation of Council Framework Decision 2003/577/JHA of 22 July 2003 on the execution in the European Union of orders freezing property or evidence (OJ L 196, 2.8.2003, p. 45).

The information is based on information provided by Member States to the Council General Secretariat, to which reference is made in the last column.

In accordance with Article 14, the Framework Decision should have been implemented by 2 August 2005.

According to the information received so far, 26 Member States (BE, BG, CZ, DK, DE, EL, ES, EE, FR, HR, IE, IT, CY, LV, LT, HU, MT, NL, AT, PL, PT, RO, SI, SK, FI, SE) have implemented the Framework Decision in their national legal order and have made the necessary notifications/declarations.<sup>1</sup>

The information in the table is a summary of the information received: delegations are invited to consult the documents referred to in the last column, in order to obtain more detailed information.
