Subject: Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers
Appointment of Ms Alexandra KRAMER, member for Germany, in place of
Ms Livia HENTSCHEL, who has resigned

1. The General Secretariat of the Council has been informed of the resignation of Ms Livia HENTSCHEL as member of the above Committee in the trade unions' representatives category (for Germany).
2. Under Article 24 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union, members and alternate members are appointed by the Council.

3. In accordance with the usual procedure, the Government of Germany has nominated the following candidate for the remainder of the current term of office, ending on 24 September 2022¹:

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union², and in particular Articles 23 and 24 thereof.

Whereas:

- (1) In its Decisions of 21 September 2020³ and 11 December 2020^{4,5}, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 24 September 2022.
- (2) A seat as member in the trade unions' representatives category has fallen vacant as a result of the resignation of Ms Livia HENTSCHEL.
- (3) The Government of Germany has submitted a nomination for the vacant seat,
