 On 14 July 2021, the Commission submitted to the Council, based on Article 349 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU), its proposal for a Council Regulation for temporarily suspending autonomous Common Customs Tariff duties on imports of certain industrial products into the Canary Islands. Although a consultation is not required by the Treaties, the Commission suggested that the Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions should be also consulted.

- 2. On that basis, and in accordance with Article 304 and 307 (TFEU) and Article 19(7)(h) of the Rules of Procedure of the Council<sup>1</sup>, <u>the Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is asked to:
  - launch a consultation of the Economic and Social Committee and of the Committee of the Regions on the above proposal; and
  - invite the Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions to give their opinion as soon as possible.
