The incoming Croatian Presidency presented its priorities for the CCWP during the first semester of 2020:

The priorities for CCWP of the Croatian Presidency are the following:

- Implementation of the 10th AP
- Further efforts to achieve synergies between EU Policy Cycle and 10 AP of CCWP
- Better visibility of customs
- Overview of appropriate supporting instrument to enhance operational work of the Working Party; funding and trainings
- Strengthening of EU external border by enhance performance of IBM
- Data protection issues in relation to the possible adjustment of legal instruments

Meetings will be held on 17 January (plenary), 13 February (experts), 4 March (experts), 24 March (joint meeting with LEWP in the morning, plenary in the afternoon), 21 April (experts), 27 May (plenary) and 24 June (plenary).
