Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the conditions of entry and residence of third-country nationals for the purpose of highly qualified employment, and repealing Council Directive 2009/50/EC (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 7 June 2016 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹ based on Article 79(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 8 December 2016².
- 3. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinions on 14 December 2016³.
- 4. On 15 September 2021, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.

- 5. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u>⁵⁶ approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 40/21, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Hungary</u> vote against and <u>Austria</u>, the <u>Czech Republic</u> and <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 6. The statement by <u>Hungary</u> for the minutes of the Council meeting is set out in the Addendum 1.
- 7. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
