TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS N° DEC 25/2021

INTRODUCTION

The present transfer proposes to move appropriations available on the administrative lines to the operational lines, due to the delayed implementation of administrative appropriations as a consequence of the late adoption of basic acts. This concerns programmes under Heading 1 (Horizon Europe, Connecting Europe Facility (CEF), Digital Europe, Single Market, Galileo/EGNOS), Heading 2b (EU4Health, Rights and Values, Justice), Heading 3 (LIFE) and Heading 5 (Defence Fund).

The commitments appropriations available under the administrative lines will be moved to the operational lines of the programmes. The payments appropriations will be moved to the operational lines of the programmes, where a need for reinforcement has been identified.

Moreover, as the differentiated payment appropriations made available in the global transfer (DEC 20/2021) for budget line 04 02 01 - Galileo/EGNOS were not sufficient to accelerate the production of the second generation of Galileo satellites, it is proposed to also reinforce Galileo/EGNOS payment appropriations.

The present transfer also includes the transfer of commitment appropriations from the Nuclear Safeguard prerogative under Heading 5 to the prerogative "Support activities for the European energy policy and internal energy market" under Heading 1.

This transfer amounts to EUR 102,2 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 101,7 million in payment appropriations.

Justifications

Support expenditure for Horizon Europe

In 2020, pending the adoption of the Horizon Europe basic act and of the renewed mandate of executive agencies, the amount of appropriations for 2021 was solely based on the 2020 budget increased by 2% for inflation. Ultimately, the costs for indirect research staff costs turned out to be lower than those initial estimated, so that an amount of EUR 4,7 million can be made available. It is proposed to transfer the commitment appropriations to the operational lines of Horizon Europe.

Other management expenditure for Horizon Europe -- Indirect research

The identified surplus of EUR 45 million is mainly due to the delays in the adoption of the Multiannual Financial Framework and Horizon Europe legal bases and the impact of the COVID-19restrictions, which reduced the costs in staff missions, expert meetings and communication. It is proposed to transfer the commitment appropriations to the operational lines of Horizon Europe.

The identified surplus of EUR 3,1 million is due to a series of factors, such as the delays in the adoption of the Multiannual Financial Framework and Horizon Europe legal bases, the subsequent approval of the renewed delegation acts of executive agencies, the uncertainties when establishing the Draft Budget 2021 (final Horizon Europe envelope and its breakdown, the respective responsibilities of each DG and executive agency), the pandemic context which delayed the recruitment of staff in the agency, and the reduction of the costs related to the corporate IT tools used by the agency for grant management (eGrants/Sedia), whose cost is now also shared under the programmes EU4Health, Connecting Europe Facility and Digital Europe. It is proposed to transfer the commitment appropriations to the operational lines of Horizon Europe.

European Innovation Council and SMEs Executive Agency -- Contribution from Horizon Europe

The identified surplus of EUR 3,6 million is due to the uncertainties during the preparation of the 2021 budget, which made it difficult to assess to its full extent the consequences on the appropriations of the new Multiannual Financial Framework and Horizon Europe legal bases, due to the delays in their adoption. The subsequent approval of the renewed delegation acts of executive agencies gave legal certainty on authorised staff figures and on their formal mandate only later in the year, hindering earlier recruitment. Compared to the initial assumptions, the recruitment of staff in executive agencies was therefore slower than planned, resulting in lower staff costs, while, in parallel, the COVID-19 pandemic also reduced the costs of staff missions and expert meetings. It is proposed to transfer the commitment appropriations to the operational lines of Horizon Europe.

The Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) 2021-2027 programme was adopted in July 2021 and the multi-annual work programme in August 2021. The launching of the CEF support actions, such as IT projects, consultancies and events, has been subsequently delayed and some contracts will only be signed in 2022. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,4 million can be made available for transfer to the operational line.

Therefore, an amount of EUR 1,4 million can be made available for transfer to operational line.

Due to a late adoption of the Work programme under the Digital Europe Programme (foreseen in the last Quarter of 2021) and the on-going COVID-19 pandemic, the actual need of administrative appropriations will be considerably lower than initially estimated. Therefore, an amount of EUR 7,6 million can be made available for transfer to an operational line.

The 2021 contribution of the Renewable Energy Financing Mechanism to the European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA) was reduced to EUR 0,3 million as per fourth amendment to CINEA's operating budget adopted by the Steering Committee on 29/09/21. The budget reduction is the consequence of delayed recruitments due to the late adoption of the programmes implemented by CINEA, to stakeholder's events held in virtual mode, and to the non-signature of the building lease extension in 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 85 575 can be made available for transfer to the operational line.

The reinforcement of EUR 1,8 million in commitment appropriations will be used to finance additional projects under the 2021 CEF transport calls for proposals.

Digitalisation being high on the Commission's agenda, the reinforcement of EUR 1,4 million in commitment appropriations for the CEF-Digital operational budget line will provide flexibility for accommodating emerging new activities from the evolution of broadband connectivity needs and the technologies supporting them as well as from the monitoring of the deployment and characterisation of (cloud) edge nodes in each Member States.

Completion of previous Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) -- Transport activities (prior to 2021)

The reinforcement of EUR 4,9 million in payment appropriations will be used to finance additional payments in 2021 for the completion of CEF—Transport 2014-2020 projects.

Completion of previous Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) -- Energy activities (prior to 2021)

The reinforcement of EUR 1,3 million in payment appropriations will be used to finance additional payments in 2021 for the completion of CEF-Energy activities. The additional need is mainly due to the reception of interim cost claims that were not foreseen in 2021, and final payments that were expected in 2022 but are anticipated to 2021.

Artificial intelligence

The set-up of the network of European Digital Innovation Hubs (EDIH) will mainly happen in the first call for proposals expected by the end of 2021. During the consultation on the EDIH Work programme that took place over the summer, Member States commented that the allocated budget to the EDIHs was too low. The reinforcement of EUR 12 million in commitment appropriations will reply to this Member States' request and trigger more investments by the Member States themselves, because of the 50% co-investments.

The budget needs for the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA) will be lower than initially estimated, reducing the contribution from the Single Market programme by EUR 1 million. The surplus is made available for the Food Chain strand within the Single Market Programme.

The reinforcement of EUR 0,2 million in commitment appropriations will be used to finance additional procurement actions in order to ensure a high level of consumer protection and product safety.

The reinforcement of EUR 1 million in commitment and payment appropriations is necessary to cover Member States' needs under the Emergency Measures, following the outbreaks of African Swine Fever and Avian Influenza, as well as plant diseases.

Galileo / EGNOS

The reinforcement of EUR 92,3 million in payment appropriations for the Galileo/EGNOS budget line will allow prefinancing the European Union Agency for the Space Programme (EUSPA).

The requested increase is mostly related to the decision to accelerate the production of the second generation of Galileo satellites, both in terms of delivery date and number of satellites. The present Galileo satellite constellation is made up of 26 satellites in orbit. Twelve more satellites are presently under construction at the company 'OHB' in Bremen, in Germany. Two of those satellites will be launched at the end of this year. With this set of satellites, the Commission will ensure service continuity until the launch of the next generation of Galileo's satellites.

From all existing satellite navigation infrastructures, Galileo offers the most accurate positioning capability. Yet, international competition is challenging our technological edge, in particular the US with its third generation GPS under deployment and China. As the development and production times between inception and full deployment are long, it is important to accelerate the deployment of Galileo second generation satellites.

Budget 2021 was established early 2020 with the initial hypothesis to order an initial batch of 4 satellites to the two companies selected for the production of the second generation of Galileo satellites (two satellites per company). With a view to accelerate the deployment of the second generation of satellites, an order of 12 satellites with the two contractors was placed (six satellites per company). It leads to a significant increase in pre-financing and first payments for the production order on these two contracts in 2021. This new planning will ensure that Galileo constellation continues to provide high rated positioning services. With the decision to accelerate the second generation, the first satellites of this generation should be placed in orbit by the end of 2024.

Regarding the launchers, 2 additional launchers were bought late 2020 for the first generation of Galileo satellites with associated payments late 2021, which was not considered when establishing the draft budget 2021. Moreover, additional appropriations are also needed for payments for the launchers of the first generation of satellites and for EGNOS.

The present reinforcement will complement the reinforcement of EUR 648,4 million in payment appropriations proposed in the global transfer (DEC 20/2021). The draft budget for 2022 already took into consideration the revised planning in the payment schedule and payment request for next year.

European Health and Digital Executive Agency -- Contribution from the EU4Health programme

Following a revision of the budget needs for the salaries, costs related to the recruitment plan, and for the rent of the building, the budget needs for the European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA) will be lower than initially estimated. Therefore, an amount of EUR 4,7 million can be made available for the operational line.

The appropriations on this budget line were mainly foreseen for events. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, no events could be organised and an amount of EUR 0,2 million can be made available.

Due to a decrease in the meeting costs during the Covid-19 pandemic, an amount of EUR 0,1 million can be made available for transfer to the operational line.

The reinforcement of EUR 0,2 million in commitment and payment appropriations will allow the funding more high quality projects.

Promoting effective access to justice

The reinforcement of EUR 0,1 million in commitment and payment appropriations will allow to the funding of more projects under the 2021 E-Justice call for proposals that was very successful (5 projects selected in the reserve list).

Support expenditure for the Programme for the Environment and Climate Action (LIFE)

The LIFE 2021-2027 programme was adopted in April 2021 and the multi-annual work programme in July 2021. The launching of the LIFE support actions, such as IT projects and consultancies, has been subsequently delayed and the contracts will be signed in 2022. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,8 million can be made available for transfer to the operational line.

The 2021 contribution of the LIFE programme to the European Climate, Infrastructure and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA) was reduced to EUR 2,4 million as per fourth amendment to CINEA's operating budget adopted by the Steering Committee on 29/09/21. The budget reduction is the consequence of delayed recruitments due to the late adoption of the programmes implemented by CINEA, to stakeholder's events held in virtual mode, and to the non-signature of the building lease extension in 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 1,9 million can be made available for transfer to the operational line.

Circular economy and quality of life

The reinforcement of EUR 1,4 million in commitment appropriations will contribute to the funding of the call for proposals for the new Bauhaus initiative (EUR 13 million).

Clean energy transition

The reinforcement of EUR 1,3 million in commitment appropriations will be used to finance additional projects under the 2021 calls for proposals.

Completion of previous programmes in the field of environment and climate action (LIFE) (prior to 2021)

Due to the temporary increase of the pre-financing rate from 30% to 40% for all LIFE grants under the 2019 and 2020 calls for proposals (grants signed in 2020 and 2021), the reinforcement of EUR 1,4 million in payment appropriations will allow more liquidity for the LIFE beneficiaries.

Nuclear safeguards

Due the Covid-19 crisis, the number of Euratom Safeguards inspections will be lower than initially estimated. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,5 million in commitment appropriations can be made available.

Due to delays in the adoption of the European Defence Fund regulation, the amount initially foreseen for the support expenditure could not be fully absorbed. In addition, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, administrative expenditure has been lower than initially planned: for example, this year only a very small part of the cost of communication activities was actually spent. Therefore, an amount of EUR 1 million can be made available for the operational line.

Due to delays in the adoption of the European Defence Fund regulation, the amount initially foreseen for other management expenditure could not be fully absorbed. The initial amount was expected to finance the research defence staff for the full year 2021. Therefore, an amount of EUR 11,6 million can be made available for the operational line.
