TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS N° DEC 27/2019

INTRODUCTION

The so-called "End-of-year Transfer" is intended to ensure that, insofar as possible, the outstanding invoices related to funds in shared management can be honoured, by making full use of available payment appropriations.

The rules governing this transfer are set out in Article 31(2) of the Regulation (EU, EURATOM) No 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the European Union.

The "End of Year Transfer" for the 2019 exercise relates to payment appropriations amounting to **EUR 255,5 million** in total, which takes into account the actual implementation of expenditure in mid-December 2019.

1. Reinforcements

The transfer proposes to reinforce the payment appropriations of **3 budget lines** under following headings/programmes:

- Heading 1b Economic, social & territorial cohesion to the European Social Fund;
- + EUR 135,5 million
- Heading 2 Sustainable growth natural resources
- + EUR 120,0 million
- o to the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EUR 100,0 million)
- o to the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund (EUR 20,0 million)

These reinforcements will allow outstanding claims to be covered, and reimburse Member States for payments already undertaken in shared management.

2. Reductions

The payment appropriations are redeployed from 33 budget lines under the following headings/programmes:

- Heading 1a Competitiveness for growth and jobs EUR 44,4 million mainly from
 - o the European Economic Recovery Plan (EUR 19.0 million)
 - o Horizon 2020 (EUR 17,9 million)
- Heading 1b Economic, social & territorial cohesion EUR 12,1 million from the European Regional Development Fund (cross border cooperation)
- Heading 3 Security & citizenship

Justifications

Decreased 01 03 02

Macro-financial assistance

No further payments are expected for macro-financial assistance (MFA) operations this year. The reason is that not all policy actions related to the instalment for the MFA-operation for Georgia were fulfilled (EUR 5,0 million) and the recent change of government in Moldova has delayed the disbursement process (EUR 10,0 million). Therefore, an amount of EUR 15,0 million in payment appropriations can be made available.

Decreased 02 07 01

European Defence Industrial Development Programme (EDIDP)

The implementation was slower than expected and an amount of EUR 0,2 million can be made available.

Increased 04 02 60

European Social Fund -- Less developed regions -- Investment for growth and jobs goal

Member States forecasts are more and more reliable and the current pace of submission of claims indicates that the payment needs exceed the remaining available appropriations. The payment appropriations released in the context of the end-of-year transfer (EUR 110,5 million) will cover these additional payments needs.

Increased 05 04 60 01

Promoting sustainable rural development, a more territorially and environmentally balanced, climate-friendly and innovative Union agricultural sector

Member States' declarations of expenditure for the third quarter of 2019 are higher than expected. The additional payment appropriations (EUR 100,0 million) will cover the needs for the 2014-2020 programmes financed by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD).

Decreased 05 05 03 02

Support for economic, social and territorial development and related progressive alignment with the Union acquis

The use of the assigned revenue from the previous programming periods resulted in a lower consumption of the payment appropriations of the 2019 voted budget. Therefore, an amount of EUR 0,2 million can be made available.

Decreased 09 02 01

Definition and implementation of the Union's policy in the field of electronic communications

The surplus of EUR 0,3 million is due to various events: translation costs lower than expected, cancellation of an interim payment for a study (report not accepted by the Commission), two payments postponed to 2020.

Decreased 09 03 04

WiFi4EU -- Support the deployment of free local Wi-Fi

Deployment of WiFi installations, which is a prerequisite for the payment of the vouchers, takes place at a slower pace than initially envisaged. Despite efforts to stimulate municipalities for a faster processing, the number of claims is lower than expected.

In addition, some invoices related to IT developments planned in 2019 were not received so that payments are to be postponed to 2020. Therefore, an amount of EUR 7.0 million can be made available.

Increased 11 06 60

Promoting sustainable and competitive fisheries and aquaculture, balanced and inclusive territorial development of fisheries areas and fostering the implementation of the common fisheries policy

Member States' declarations of expenditure for 2019 are higher than expected. The additional payment appropriations (EUR 20,0 million) will cover the needs for the 2014-2020 operational programmes financed by the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund (EMFF).

Decreased 13 05 03 01

Completion of cross-border cooperation (CBC) -- Contribution from Subheading 1b

The closure of projects has proceeded at a slower pace than foreseen. Therefore, an amount of EUR 4,6 million can be made available.

Decreased 13 05 03 02

Completion of cross-border cooperation (CBC) and participation of candidate and potential candidate countries in Structural Funds-- transnational and interregional cooperation programmes -- Contribution from Heading 4

The closure of projects has proceeded at a slower pace than foreseen. Therefore, an amount of EUR 4,9 million can be made available.

Decreased 13 05 63 01

Cross-border cooperation (CBC) -- Contribution from Heading 1b

Payment requests expected for 2019 will arrive too late to allow payment before year-end. Therefore, an amount of EUR 7,6 million can be made available.

Decreased 13 05 63 02

Cross-border cooperation (CBC) -- Contribution from Heading 4

Payment requests expected in 2019 will arrive too late to allow payment before year-end. Therefore, an amount of EUR 7,6 million can be made available.

Decreased 18 02 03

European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex)

Following the adoption of Regulation (EU) 2019/1896 of 13 November 2019¹, enhancing the mandate of European Border and Coast Guard Agency, the Commission released EUR 19,3 million in commitment and payment appropriations from the reserve. The Agency confirmed that it will not need these appropriations in 2019. The commitment appropriations were transferred to reinforce National Programmes under the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund, and the payment appropriations can be made available.

Decreased 18 03 01 01

Strengthening and developing the common European asylum system and enhancing solidarity and responsibility-sharing between the Member States

The surplus of EUR 20,0 million stems from delays in the submission of grant applications related to Emergency assistance.

Decreased 18 04 01 01

Europe for citizens -- Strengthening remembrance and enhancing capacity for civic participation at the Union level

The surplus of EUR 0,9 million is mainly due to lower final payments on grants than initially estimated. This is triggered by delays in the submission of final reports or the submission of incomplete information by the grant beneficiaries.

Decreased 21 02 01

Cooperation with Latin America

There have been delays in the contracting with and implementation by International Organisations (the International Development Bank and the World Bank) mainly in Nicaragua. The remaining payment appropriations of EUR 6,5 million can therefore be made available.

Decreased 21 02 02

Cooperation with Asia

There have been delays in the negotiations of contracts for Myanmar and Sri Lanka (including contracts with the World Bank), as well as in the implementation of projects and submission of reports in Indonesia. The remaining payment appropriations of EUR 25,0 million can therefore be made available.

Decreased 21 02 03

Cooperation with Central Asia

The surplus of EUR 9,5 million in payment appropriations is due to a delay in the signature of the financing agreement with Tajikistan, which will not allow the signing of contracts and processing the first pre-financing before the end of the year.

Decreased 21 02 04

Cooperation with the Middle East

There have been delays in the processing of the first pre-financing for a project in Yemen (bank guarantee requested), as well as some delays in the implementation of projects in Iraq and Yemen, leading to non-submission of new requests for pre-financing in 2019. The remaining payment appropriations of EUR 20,0 million can therefore be made available.

Decreased 21 02 05

Cooperation with Afghanistan

The surplus of EUR 10,0 million in payment appropriations is due to a delayed signature of a contract amendment with the World Bank.

Decreased 21 02 07 02

Sustainable energy

There have been extensive negotiations with Development Finance Institutions to which the implementation of Financial Instruments was awarded under the EU blending framework. In particular, the protracted negotiations for the conclusion of two new agreements with the "Agence Française de Développement" and the extension of an ongoing agreement with the Netherlands Development Finance Company (FMO) led to the postponement of payments for EUR 10,0 million to 2020. The corresponding 2019 payment appropriations can therefore be made available.

Decreased 21 02 09

Pan-African programme to support the Joint Africa-European Union Strategy

The surplus of EUR 15,0 million in payment appropriations is due to:

- delays in some works contracts (notably Trans-Saharan backbone project, with an initial forecast for EUR 5,0 million);
- some contracts have not materialised;
- some advance payments were lower than initially expected (notably on a EUR 14,0 million contract with Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KfW) Bank, where only EUR 0,8 million were paid).

Decreased 21 02 51 01

Cooperation with third countries in the areas of migration and asylum

The surplus of EUR 9,6 million is due to a slower than expected implementation of the remaining outstanding commitments.

Decreased 21 02 51 03

Cooperation with developing countries in Asia, including Central Asia and the Middle East

The surplus of EUR 5,5 million is due to the postponement of a payment related to a project in Indonesia and a slower than expected implementation of the remaining outstanding commitments.

Decreased 21 02 51 08

Geographical cooperation with Africa, Caribbean and Pacific states

The surplus of EUR 12,5 million is mainly explained by unexpected delays in the implementation of the numerous financial agreements signed with the Africa, Caribbean and Pacific states. As a result, part of the remaining outstanding commitments will be de-committed.

Decreased 21 02 77 14

Global Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Fund (GEEREF)

This pilot project will not be extended, as the action, which ended in May 2019, is linked to the Global Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Fund that is also ending. The payment appropriations of EUR 0,5 million can thus be made available.

Pilot project -- Strengthening veterinary services in developing countries

No further payments are expected on this pilot project in 2019. The surplus of EUR 0,5 million can therefore be made available.

Pilot project -- Education services for children formerly associated with armed forces and groups in the Greater Pibor Administrative Area (GPAA) in South Sudan

This Pilot Project started on 01/01/2019. As the first implementation report will be submitted on 31/12/2019, there will be no additional payment in 2019. Therefore, EUR 55 153 can be made available.

Pilot project -- Supporting the urban dimension of development cooperation: increasing financial capacities of cities in developing countries to deliver productive and sustainable urban development

The start of project activities was delayed because of difficulties encountered during the negotiations of the Agreement of Cooperation with an implementing partner. Therefore, the available payment appropriations of EUR 0,5 million will not be used this year and can be made available.

Preparatory action -- Support for micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMMEs) in developing countries

The contracts under this preparatory action have been fully paid. The surplus of EUR 75 000 can therefore be made available.

Decreased 23 03 01 01

Disaster prevention and preparedness within the Union

The surplus of EUR 3,0 million is due to longer than expected contract negotiations delaying pre-financing payments, and the late submission of final reports.

Decreased 23 03 02 01

Rapid and efficient emergency response interventions in the event of major disasters within the Union

The number of activations of the Union Civil Protection Mechanism during the year is unpredictable by nature, since it depends on the emergencies that will occur within the EU and the number of transports interventions that will be requested. The year 2019 has known a low level of activity bearing costs, resulting in lower payment needs. Therefore, an amount of EUR 2,7 million can be made available.

Preparatory action -- Linked open data in European public administration

The implementation of this preparatory action is complex and involves more than 25 different projects managed by different services within the Publications Office and the Commission. This has caused some delay and payments will be postponed to 2020. Therefore, an amount of EUR 75 000 can be made available.

Completion of energy projects to aid economic recovery

The surplus of EUR 19,0 million is due to delays on two projects financed under the 2009-2013 programme for energy projects to aid economic recovery.

Decreased 32 04 03 01

Making the transition to a reliable, sustainable and competitive energy system

The surplus of EUR 13,0 million is mainly due to the later than expected signature of some projects from the reserve lists, leading to reduced pre-financing needs (EUR 8,0 million), and to the postponement to 2020 of first payments related to contracts for common support actions signed later than expected (EUR 5,0 million).

Completion of the 'Intelligent energy -- Europe' programme (2007 to 2013)

Only one payment was made during the year, using available external assigned revenue (from the European Free Trade Association). There will be no other payment in 2019. Therefore, the amount of EUR 4,9 million can be made available.
