THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1069/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 October 2009 laying down health rules as regards animal by-products and derived products not intended for human consumption and repealing Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002¹, and in particular the first subparagraph of Article 41(3) and Article 42(2)(a) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The French language version of Commission Regulation (EU) No 142/2011² contains an error in the title and in point 1 of section 2 of Chapter VI of Annex XIV as regards the listing of third countries, rendering the meaning opposite to the one intended.
- (2) The French language version of Regulation (EU) No 142/2011 should therefore be corrected accordingly. The other language versions are not affected.
- (3) The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

(does not concern the English language)

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
