Subject: Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Directive 2009/103/EC relating to insurance against civil liability in respect of the use of motor vehicles, and the enforcement of the obligation to insure against such liability **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 24 May 2018 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 19 September 2018².
3. On 21 October 2021 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council³.

5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to:
 - confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 60/21, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting;
 - decide that the Commission's statement, as set out in the Addendum 1 to this note, to be published in the L series of the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
6. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
