d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

In line with point 19 of the Inter-Institutional Agreement on the 2014-2020 Multiannual Financial Framework (2013/C 373/01), the available commitment (EUR 63,3 million) and payment appropriations (EUR 55 million) can be transferred from the reserve 40 02 41 to the operational budget line 11 03 01 to cover the needs resulting from legal obligations related to the implementation of the EU Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreements.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

The reinforcement is needed to honour the obligations resulting from the new Protocol implementing the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement (SFPA) between the EU and the Republic of Senegal (EUR 1,7 million in commitment appropriations) and the extension of the current Protocol, expiring on 15 November 2019, implementing the SFPA between the EU and the Islamic Republic of Mauritania (EUR 61,6 million in commitment appropriations and EUR 55 million in payment appropriations).

The Commission has already proposed the signature of the new protocol with the Republic of Senegal on 17 October (COM(2019) 475) and the extension of the protocol with the Islamic Republic of Mauritania on 1 October (COM(2019) 448). The Council is expected to adopt these proposals before end of November allowing their signature and provisional application before the end of the year.
