Temporary derogation from the Council's rules of procedure

Owing to exceptional circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic, on 23 April 2020 the Council agreed on a temporary derogation from its rules of procedure to make it easier to take decisions by written procedure. The temporary derogation is currently in force until 30 September 2021 (2021/1142). It may be renewed if justified by a continuation of the current exceptional circumstances.

The derogation allows member states' EU ambassadors sitting in the Committee of Permanent Representatives (Coreper) to decide to use the written procedure in accordance with the voting rule applicable to the adoption of the act itself. It means that the requirement for unanimity for all decisions adopted using the written procedure no longer applies. The objective is to facilitate the use of the written procedure to help ensure the continuity of Council business.

Temporary derogation from the Council's Rules of Procedure due to COVID-19

The Council adopted a Decision further extending the temporary derogation from the Council's Rules of Procedure introduced by Decision (EU) 2020/430, in view of the travel difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in the Union, as set out in document 11875/21.

JUSTICE AND HOME AFFAIRS

EU-UK relations

The Council adopted a decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the EU in the Specialised Committee on Law Enforcement and Judicial Cooperation established by the Trade and Cooperation Agreement (TCA) between the EU and the UK, regarding the extension of the period during which DNA profiles and fingerprints can be exchanged with the UK (11697/21).

The position to be taken on the EU's behalf shall be to agree to an extension until 30 June 2022 of the period during which member states may continue to exchange personal data as referred to in Articles 530, 531 and 534 of the TCA and supply further available personal data as referred to in Article 536 of the TCA with the UK.
