## **Updates to Commission Proposal for a Council Regulation fixing for 2022 the fishing opportunities for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks applicable in Union waters and for Union fishing vessels in certain non-Union waters (COM(2021) 661)**

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## **1. AMENDMENTS IN RELATION TO NEAFC STOCKS AND UNILATERAL QUOTAS IN THE NORTH EAST ATLANTIC**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

When proposing fishing opportunities for stocks in the NEAFC regulatory area, the Commission takes into account the ICES scientific advice, the adopted NEAFC recommendations, or where no recommendations are adopted, the European Union's positions in NEAFC.

The NEAFC annual meeting was prepared in the Council working party on 4 November 2021. NEAFC held its annual meeting from 9 to 12 November 2021.

ICES issued a zero catch scientific advice for shallow pelagic and deep pelagic redfish in ICES subareas 5, 12, and 14 and in NAFO subareas 1 and 2. For these two redfish stocks in the Irminger Sea and adjacent waters, at its annual meeting, NEAFC adopted a conservation measure, prohibiting directed fisheries of those stocks. In addition, it prohibited fishing activities in the area where redfish aggregates, to minimise its by-catches. The Commission therefore proposes to implement these measures in Union law.

ICES also issued scientific advice for beaked redfish in ICES subareas 1 and 2 for catches of 67 210 tonnes in 2022. For redfish in international waters of ICES subareas 1 and 2, the Union submitted a proposal for a TAC of 16 802 tonnes, corresponding to 25% of the amount indicated in the ICES advice. However, NEAFC was unable to adopt a recommendation for that stock. In the absence of an agreement in NEAFC, the Commission proposes to set a TAC for this stock in line with the EU position in NEAFC.

As regards Greenland halibut in international waters of ICES subareas 1 and 2, the Commission proposes to set a TAC of 1 766 tonnes, taking into account the ICES scientific advice for 2022.

### **AMENDMENTS TO THE RECITALS**

Recital (23) is replaced by the following:

“(23) At its annual meeting in 2021, the North-East Atlantic Fisheries Commission (NEAFC) adopted a conservation measure for the two redfish stocks in the Irminger Sea and adjacent waters, prohibiting directed fisheries of those stocks. In addition, in order to minimise by-catches, the NEAFC prohibited fishing activities in the area where redfish aggregates. These

measures, based on the ICES advice for zero catches, should be implemented in Union law. The NEAFC was unable to adopt a recommendation for redfish in ICES subareas 1 and 2. For that stock, the relevant TAC should be established in line with the Union position expressed in NEAFC.”Recital (23a) added:

“(23a) For Greenland halibut in international waters of ICES subareas 1 and 2, taking into account the ICES scientific advice for 2022, a TAC of 1 766 tonnes should be fixed.”

## AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES

In Chapter III, the following Section is inserted:

### “SECTION 2 NEAFC CONVENTION AREA

#### *Article 18 Closures for redfish in the Irminger*

All fishing activities shall be prohibited in the area bounded by following co- ordinates measured according to the WGS84 system:

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## 2. CORRECTIONS

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

The corrections include a drafting correction (Article 47a). The corrections also include corrections of errors in Annex IC (NAFO Convention Area). Some errors stem from rounding errors (cod in NAFO 3M, and redfishes in NAFO 3M), while other errors stem from input errors (shortfin squid in NAFO subareas 3 and 4, and skates in NAFO 3LNO). For cod in NAFO 3M, the sum of Member States' quotas calculated on the basis of relative stability is 1 907 tonnes, one tonne below the Union quota of 1 908 tonnes. Following established practice, the difference is added to the quota of the Member State with the highest quota, in this case Portugal.

### AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE 47A

Article 47a is replaced by the following:

#### *“Article 47a*

#### *Quota transfers and exchanges with the United Kingdom*

- ~~(2)~~ (1) Any quota transfer or exchange between the Union and the United Kingdom shall take place in accordance with paragraphs 2 to 4.
- ~~(3)~~ (2) A Member State intending to transfer or exchange quotas with the United Kingdom may discuss with the United Kingdom an outline of the quota transfer or exchange. The concerned Member State shall notify the Commission of the outline.

- (4) (3) Where the Commission endorses an outline of the quota transfer or exchange referred to in paragraph 2 notified by the Member State concerned, the Commission shall express, without undue delay, the consent to be bound by such quota transfer or exchange. The Commission shall notify the United Kingdom and the Member States of the agreed quota transfer or exchange.
- (5) (4) The quota received from or transferred to the United Kingdom under the agreed quota transfer or exchange shall be deemed to be quotas allocated to, or deducted from, the allocation of the Member State concerned, as of the moment that the quota transfer or exchange has been notified in accordance with paragraph 3. Such exchanges shall not affect the distribution key for allocating fishing opportunities among Member States in line with the principle of relative stability of fishing activities.”
