THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 November 2002 on the Common Procurement Vocabulary (CPV)<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 2 thereof,

After consulting the Advisory Committee for Public Contracts,

Whereas:

- (1) The Croatian and Estonian language versions of Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 contain an error in Annex I, in the table 'Main Vocabulary', second column as regards the Common Procurement Vocabulary (CPV) code 79530000-8.
- (2) The Croatian and Estonian language versions of Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 should therefore be corrected accordingly. The other language versions are not affected,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the twentieth day following that of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
