d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

In line with point 20 of the Inter-Institutional Agreement on the 2021-2027 Multiannual Financial Framework, amounts provided for in the budget for new fisheries agreements or for the renewal of fisheries agreements, which enter into force after 1 January of the financial year concerned, shall be included in reserve.

It is proposed to transfer an amount of EUR 287 500 (in commitment and payment appropriations) from this reserve to the operational budget line 08 05 01 to cover the financial obligations resulting from the adoption of the extension of the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Mauritius.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

The reinforcement of the operational line by EUR 287 500 (in commitment and payment) appropriations is necessary to honour the 2022 financial obligations resulting from the adoption of the extension of the Sustainable Fisheries Partnership Agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Mauritius.

Following the Commission proposal COM(2022) 22 of 25 January 2022, the Council agreed on the conclusion and provisional application of the Implementing Protocol on 11 February 2022. The first access payment is due within 90 days following the entering into force of the Implementing Protocol.
