Subject:	Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations on a status agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Moldova on operational activities carried out by the European Border and Coast Guard Agency in the Republic of Moldova
	Adoption

- 1. On 9 March 2022, the Commission submitted to the Council a recommendation for a Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations on a status agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Moldova on operational activities carried out by the European Border and Coast Guard Agency on the territory of the Republic of Moldova, together with negotiating directives, as set out in document 7060/22 + ADD 1.
- 2. At their meeting on 10 March 2022, the JHA Counsellors examined the above recommendation and the negotiating directives. The proposal received broad support.
- 3. Following legal-linguistic revision, the text of the draft Council Decision is set out in document 7080/22.

- 4. This Decision constitutes a development of the provisions of the Schengen acquis in which Ireland does not take part, in accordance with Council Decision 2002/192/EC of 28 February 2002 concerning Ireland's request to take part in some of the provisions of the Schengen acquis¹. Ireland is therefore not taking part in the adoption of this Decision and is not bound by it or subject to its application.
- 5. In accordance with Articles 1 and 2 of Protocol No 22 on the position of Denmark, annexed to the Treaty on European Union and to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, Denmark is not taking part in the adoption of this Decision and is not bound by it or subject to its application.
- In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited 6.
 - to suggest that the Council adopt the Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations on a status agreement between the European Union and the Republic of Moldova on operational activities carried out by the European Border and Coast Guard Agency on the territory of the Republic of Moldova as set out in document 7080/22 which refers to the negotiating directives as set out in document 7080/22 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting; and
 - to request the publication of the text of the decision as adopted by the Council in the Official Journal of the European Union.
