Subject:	COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX correcting certain language versions of Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Common Procurement Vocabulary (CPV) - Decision not to oppose adoption

1. On 19 January 2022, the Commission submitted the above draft Regulation to the Council, in accordance with Article 2 of Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 (CPV).¹

Pursuant to the procedure in Article 5a of Council Decision 1999/468/EC², such draft measures, before being formally adopted by the Commission, are submitted for scrutiny to the European Parliament and the Council. If neither the European Parliament nor the Council have opposed the measures envisaged by the Commission, the draft Regulation shall be adopted by the Commission.

2. The Croatian and Estonian language versions of Regulation (EC) No 2195/2002 contain an error in Annex I, in the second column of the table ‘Main Vocabulary’.
 3. On 6 July 2021, the Advisory Committee for Public Contracts voted unanimously in favour of the measure in accordance with Article 5a(2) of Council Decision 1999/468/EC.
 4. On 28 January 2022, delegations were asked by 16 March 2022 to indicate their possible opposition to the draft Regulation. No delegation raised any relevant grounds for opposition. The official date for scrutiny ends on 20 April 2022.
 5. Against this background, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to recommend to the Council to confirm its non-opposition to the draft Regulation, as set out in document ST 5764/22 as an item without discussion at one of its forthcoming meetings.
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
