Summary

Stefano Besseghini was born in Tirano (SO) on 14.09.1966, he graduated in Physics at University of Milan (1992 - 105/110) and obtained his specialization in Materials Science and Technology at the same University (1995 - 70/70 cum laude).

Immediately after his military duties (1994), he is offered to take care of the start-up of the new branch office in Lecco of the, at that time called, Institute for the Technology of Non-Traditional Metallic Materials of the National Council Research (CNR) within the framework of an agreement between the same institute, the Centre Innovation Lecco and the Municipality of Lecco.

Since 1996, he has been in charge of the laboratory, working with large autonomy on all strategic and management aspects thanks to the broad delegation granted by the governance structures of the Institute, obtaining, among other things, the forerunner development of research into NiMnGa-based shape memory ferromagnets and the decisive contribution made to the development of the first peripheral stent in NiTi for cardiology applications developed with biomedical SORIN.

In the period 2002-2005 he coordinated the construction of a 5 tons/month plant at the site of national interest of Casale Monferrato for the experimentation of a CNR patent for asbestos inertisation (CORDIAM). This specific activity gave him considerable experience in managing large projects, technologically complex and characterized by a strong plant component

He has constantly promoted a strong connection with the local stakeholders, collaborating to the establishment of a network of laboratories (Politecnico di Milano, Istituto Villa Beretta, IRCCS La Nostra Famiglia and CNR) which in 2003 received funding (5 Mio€) of the Cariplo Foundation for the

development of the project HINT@Lecco. He worked here as head of the CNR working group (budget 950k€) and as member of the project management board.

Since 2007 he has been **project manager** within the programme agreement between Lombardy Region and CNR in relation to the following projects:

- Project 1: New technologies and tools for energy efficiency and use emissions from renewable sources in residential end use" (budget 3,6 M€)
- Project 3: High-tech processes and consumer-oriented products for the competitiveness of Lombard manufacturing" (budget 1,5M€)

He promoted the establishment of a small cultural association the Center for the Energy Studies of the Poschiavo Pole on financing from a local utility (Raetia Energie now RePower) and between September 2005 and the September 2007 organized a cycle of conferences on energy technologies which was attended by J. Rifkin, A.V. Bridgewater, A. Zichichi, F. Inzoli and M. Gasparotto.

He has taught as part of the degree course in Materials Science of the University of Milan Bicocca in the period 2003-2008 as holder of the course of Metal Physics and Metal Physics Laboratory.

Since 2007, he has been managing director of a new territorial entity in the Province of Sondrio, the Innovation Pole of the Valtellina (Politec), promoted by local authorities (Province of Sondrio and Chamber of Commerce) in the form of a cooperative society participated by the main local operators and aimed at local development through access to innovation by companies.

He dedicated its activity to the development of the three main lines of strategic development of the initiative

- a) broadband coverage of the Province of Sondrio using Wimax technology
- b) the development of a service for the promotion of technological innovation and the micro-businesses that characterize the industrial fabric of the territory
- c) the development of the voluntary energy efficiency label "Valtellina ECOenergy" as a synthesis of the best experiences developed in Trentino, Austria and Switzerland.

In **November 2010**, he was designated as a member of the board of directors of RSE spa (www.rse-web.it) by the Ministry of Economic Development. RSE is a company wholly State-owned subsidiary of the GSE group, the objective of which is to carrying out research activities in the national electro-energy sector in connection with the funding guaranteed by the System Research Fund of the Ministry of Economic Development. After an initial co-optation in the period November 2010 - April 2011 he received the assignment as Managing Director for the three-year period 2011-2013 and as Managing Director and President for the three-year period 2014-2016 and 2017-2019.

During his duties as managing director and President of RSE, Dr. Besseghini has been in a position to operate within institutional mandates also of an international nature, on behalf of MiSE and MAECI in support of internalization initiatives. Participated in the World Future Energy Summit in Abu Dhabi (2011 and 2012), the Clean Energy Ministerial in Abu Dhabi (2011) and London (2012). In November 2012 was part of the mission of Prime Minister Senator Monti to of ICE and GSE in the meetings at the Dubai Chamber of Commerce and with Ambassador Starace in Abu Dhabi.

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In June 2014 it was indicated by the Assembly of Members as vice-president of the energy cluster of the Lombardy Region (Lombardy Energy Cleantech Cluster) office reconfirmed in July 2017.

In July 2016 he was appointed by the Municipality of Legnano as President of Aemme Linea Ambiente an in-house company for the collection of waste in 17 municipalities in the north of Milan and in particular has taken care of the development of the project for the realization of a plant for the production of biomethane from municipal waste.

In July 2018, he was indicated by the Italian government on a proposal by the Ministry of Economic Development and the Ministry of Environment as President of the Italian Authority for Energy, Networks and Environment (ARERA)
