Legislation
Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on
the minimum level of training of seafarers (codification)
COM(2020) 739 final of 18.11.2020 - 2020/0329 (COD)

1. The Commission proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the minimum level of training of seafarers (codification) COM(2020) 739 final of 18.11.2020 - 2020/0329 (COD) was circulated to delegations on 20 November 2020 by document ST 13189/20 + ADD1.

The delegations were requested to submit their comments on the codification proposal within the established deadline (18 December 2020).

No horizontal comments were submitted by the delegations.

2. **CZ** submitted language-related comments, which will be dealt with by the lawyer-linguists at the stage of the legal-linguistic revision.

3. The opinion of the Consultative Working Party of Legal Services was circulated to delegations on 8 April 2021 (document 7646/21). **A second opinion of the Consultative Working Party of Legal Services was circulated to delegations on 28 March 2022 (document 7195/22).** The analysis of the three legal services confirms that the codification proposal is a straightforward codification of existing texts, without any change in their substance.
 4. The European Committee of the Regions was consulted on the codification proposal. The decision of the European Committee of the Regions not to issue an opinion was circulated to the delegations on 14 December 2020 (document ST 14041/20).
 5. The European Economic and Social Committee was consulted on the codification proposal. The Opinion of the European Economic and Social Committee was circulated to delegations on 29 January 2021 (document ST 5752/21). The European Economic and Social Committee endorses the content of the codification proposal.
