Subject:	Attendance of EIGE at the Social Questions Working Party on 18 March 2025

The European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE) is preparing a study entitled "BPFA+30: The sixth review of the implementation of the Beijing Platform for Action in the EU Member States", which will serve as important background for a set of draft Council Conclusions" prepared by the Presidency.

On 18 March 2025, the Presidency intends to organise a meeting of the Social Questions Working Party to discuss the draft Conclusions. The Presidency intends to invite EIGE to present its report at the beginning of this meeting, before the Working Party begins its deliberations.
