d) Detailed grounds for the decrease

Pursuant to Article 9 of the Multiannual Financial Framework Regulation, the Solidarity and Emergency Aid Reserve (SEAR) is constituted of two instruments which may be used to finance, respectively:

- (a) assistance to respond to emergency situations resulting from major disasters that are covered by the European Union Solidarity Fund, the objectives and scope of which are set out in Council Regulation (EC) No 2012/2002 (the "European Solidarity Reserve"); and
- (b) rapid responses to specific emergency needs within the Union or in third countries following events which could not be foreseen when the budget was established, in particular for emergency responses and support operations following natural disasters not covered by point (a), man-made disasters, humanitarian crises in cases of large-scale public health, veterinary or phytosanitary threats, as well as in situations of particular pressure at the Union's external borders resulting from migratory flows, where circumstances so require (the "Emergency Aid Reserve")

Point 10 of the Interinstitutional Agreement of 16 December 2020 between the European Parliament, the Council of the European Union and the European Commission on budgetary discipline, on cooperation on budgetary matters and on sound financial management, as well as on new own resources, including a roadmap towards the introduction of new own resources (IIA), lays down the modalities for the mobilisation of the European Union Solidarity Fund (EUSF) in the context of the SEAR.

d) Detailed grounds for the increase

Following the floods caused by the torrential rains that hit several areas of eastern Spain (DANA floods) in October 2024, Spain applied for assistance under the "major disaster" criterion of the EUSF Regulation and requested an advance payment.

Under the EUSF Regulation, advance payments to Member States are capped at 25% of the anticipated financial contribution and cannot exceed EUR 100 000 000. To facilitate this request, a transfer of EUR 100 000 000 in commitment and payment appropriations from the European Solidarity Reserve to the EUSF operational budget line is necessary.

In addition to the amount carried over from the financial year 2024 of EUR 12 926 997, the operational budget line includes, in both commitment and payment appropriations, an amount of EUR 50 000 000 already inscribed in the General Budget 2025. Considering the advance payment of EUR 10 663 578 requested by Austria for the floods of September 2024, the transfer of EUR 100 000 000 from the European Solidarity Reserve will allow to award the advance payment to Spain while leaving on the budget line a total of EUR 52 263 419 to cover potential new applications for advances.
