On behalf of the European Union, I have the honour to submit for inclusion in CITES Appendix III, pursuant to paragraph 1 of Article XVI of the Convention, the species

Gallotia galloti.

The species is endemic to Spain (Canary Islands). A copy of the relevant domestic law applicable to its protection is attached to this submission, in line with paragraph 4 of Article XVI.

In line with paragraph 3 of Resolution Conf. 9.25 (Rev. CoP18), this addition to Appendix III should enter into force on the same date as any amendments to Appendices I and II adopted at the 20th meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention.
