Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... of 27.8.2024 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2023/988 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to rules on access to and operation of the Safety Gate Rapid Alert System, information to be entered in that System, notification requirements and the criteria for assessment of the level of risk - Intention not to rise objections to the delegated act

1. The Commission has submitted the above-mentioned delegated act¹ to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFUE and in Article 26(10) of Regulation (EU) 2023/988² on General Product Safety.
2. The Commission notified this Delegated regulation on 27 August 2024, therefore, the Council may object to it until the 28 November 2024.

3. The Working Party on Consumer Protection and Information examined the delegated act through an informal consultation and at its meeting held on 6 November 2024. Discussion at the Working Party on Consumers Protection and Information meeting demonstrated that the majority required to object to this Delegated Regulation was not reached.
 4. After expiry of the three months period for objection, and unless the European Parliament objects to it, the Delegated Regulation shall be published and shall enter into force on the twentieth day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union, in accordance with Article 3 of the Delegated Regulation.
 5. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee (Part 1) is invited to recommend to the Council to confirm, as an “A” item at one of its forthcoming meetings, its intention not to raise an objection to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof.
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
